- There is parking at the back of the cottage for two cars.

- The key is situated in a box at the back of the cottage; the code will be given to you a couple of days before arrival.

## RESTAURANTS, HOTELS, PUBS

## AKELD

*The village of Akeld is situated on the northern limit of the Northumberland National Park at the foot of the Cheviot Hills. Akeld falls within the district commonly known as Glendale. It is approximately 10 miles from the Scottish Border and a short distance to the west of the market town of Wooler.*

*The cottage is situated in a lovely square just off the **A697** with fantastic views.*

## AKELD COTTAGE

**Sleeps up to 6 people**, with three bedrooms. One with a double bed, one with twin beds and the smaller room has bunk beds,

There are French doors leading from the sitting room into a large enclosed garden with a patio and garden furniture. A barbeque is also provided, for those sunny evenings. There is a colour TV with digital free view, a video recorder and DVD player. The cottage has central heating and there are plenty of heaters if needed.

The kitchen has an electric cooker, microwave oven and a washing machine.

Well behaved dogs are welcome by prior arrangement and there are plenty of places to take them for a walk, as the garden opens out onto the slopes of Akeld Hill

## HORSE RIDING

For those wishing to ride, the BHS approved Kimmerston Riding Centre caters for riders of all ages and abilities. It is owned and run by ourselves and is approximately 3 miles from Akeld Cottage.

## WALKING

The Cheviots Hills are on your doorstep. Directly from the cottage you can walk straight up Yeavinger Bell, famous for its wild goat herd.
